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8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 10 **Section 1.** W.S. 11-1-103, 11-18-117(a), (b), by
- 11 creating new subsections (c) and (e) and by amending and
- 12 renumbering (c) as (f) is amended to read:

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14 11-1-103. Penalty for violations.

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1 A person who violates any of the following sections commits

2 a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than

- 3 six (6) months, a fine of not more than seven hundred fifty
- 4 dollars (\$750.00), or both for the first offense, or by
- 5 imprisonment for not more than one (1) year, a fine of not
- 6 more than one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500.00), or
- 7 both for second or subsequent offenses: W.S. 11-6-210(a) or
- 8 (f), 11-18-112, 11-18-117(f), 11-19-101, 11-19-102,
- 9 11-19-103, 11-19-111, 11-19-401, 11-20-114, 11-20-117,
- 10 11-20-229, 11-20-230, 11-21-104, 11-22-118, 11-23-106,
- 11 11-23-207, 11-24-106, 11-30-114 and 11-48-102. A person who
- 12 violates board rules promulgated pursuant to W.S.
- 13 11-18-103(a)(v) shall be subject to the penalties specified
- 14 in this section.

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16 11-18-117. Confidentiality of livestock premises and

17 identification and traceability records; penalties.

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- 19 (a) Except as provided by subsection (b) of this
- 20 section, all records, data and information collected by the
- 21 state, recorded or otherwise, for the purposes of $\frac{a}{a}$
- 22 national the Wyoming livestock identification and
- 23 traceability program shall be confidential and are not
- 24 public records for purposes of W.S. 16-4-201 through

1 16-4-205. The records, data and information shall may be released only upon order of the Wyoming livestock board 2 state veterinarian to appropriate governmental agencies for 3 the purposes of a national the Wyoming livestock 4 5 identification and traceability program, disease outbreak trace back or law enforcement investigation. 6 The board state veterinarian shall not release any records, data or 7 information to a federal agency until the agency confirms 8 9 in writing that it will maintain the records, data and information as confidential, unless compelled by law to 10 11 release the records, data or information, and that they are not subject to the federal Freedom of Information Act, 5 12 13 U.S.C. § 552, as amended. Upon release by the board state veterinarian of any information to any other governmental 14 entity, the board state veterinarian shall notify the 15 person to whom the information refers or pertains that the 16 17 release has been made, the name of the entity to whom the information was released and shall provide a copy or 18 summary of the information contained in the release. 19 records, data and information shall not be subject to 20 21 discovery or introduction into evidence in any civil 22 action.

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The Wyoming livestock board state veterinarian 1 may release information collected for the purposes of $\frac{a}{a}$ 2 national the Wyoming livestock identification 3 4 traceability program related to the ownership and location 5 of individual animals to the extent the information is useful in controlling or preventing a disease outbreak or 6 to show particular animals or herds are not involved in a 7 disease outbreak. The information released may be a public 8 9 release or may be limited to specific individuals with a need to know the information, as the livestock board state 10 11 veterinarian deems the circumstances require.

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13 (c) The Wyoming livestock board shall establish and 14 maintain a Wyoming livestock identification and traceability program for the purpose of traceability. 15 Participation in the program shall be voluntary except as 16 17 otherwise provided by law. Except as provided in subsections (a) and (b) of this section, all information 18 19 collected for the Wyoming livestock identification and traceability program shall be maintained in confidentiality 20 21 by the Wyoming livestock board. The Wyoming livestock 22 identification and traceability program shall incorporate 23 existing livestock identification and traceability systems 24 enacted by the Wyoming livestock board or the

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veterinarian in accordance with the authority granted by 1 W.S. 11-18-101 through 11-18-117 and 11-19-101 through 2 11-19-602 to the maximum extent practicable. The Wyoming 3 4 livestock board shall promulgate rules and regulations of 5 the Wyoming livestock identification and traceability program, including the types of identification and tracing 6 devices that are acceptable for use, the categories and 7 species of livestock authorized to be identified or traced, 8 9 acceptable conditions for replacement of approved 10 identification devices by the livestock producers and other information as determined necessary by the Wyoming 11 livestock board to protect and promote 12 the Wyoming 13 livestock industry. 14 (e) Nothing in this section shall prohibit a 15 livestock animal producer from using additional livestock 16 17 tags for purposes of livestock management and producer 18 identification. 19 (c)(f) A who knowingly provides 20 person information to the Wyoming livestock board for purposes of 21 a national the Wyoming livestock identification and 22 23 traceability program shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of up to one thousand dollars 24

1 (\$1,000.00), imprisonment for up to six (6) months, or both

2 and punished as provided in W.S. 11-1-103.

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4 Section 2. W.S. 11-18-117(d) is repealed.

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Section 3. There is appropriated from the general 6 fund forty-three thousand fifteen dollars (\$43,015.00) to 7 the Wyoming livestock board for the purpose of implementing 8 9 maintaining the Wyoming livestock identification and 10 This appropriation shall be for the period 11 beginning with the effective date of this act and ending June 30, 2014. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, 12 13 this appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any other purpose. Any unexpended, unobligated funds shall 14

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Section 4. This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
