A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the Crime Victims Compensation Act;
2 clarifying reporting requirements for recipients of crime
3 victim services grants; and providing for an effective
4 date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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8 **Section 1.** W.S. 1-40-118(e) and 9-1-638(a)(v) are
9 amended to read:

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11 **1-40-118. Distribution of monies to crime victim**
12 **service and victim assistance providers.**

14 (e) In determining whether a victim service provider
15 is eligible to receive grants under subsection (d) of this
16 section, the primary consideration shall be whether the

1 eligibility requirements of the granting source are met,
2 including the provider's agreement to submit an annual
3 unduplicated count of the number of victims it served in
4 accordance with rules and regulations promulgated by the
5 division.

7 **9-1-638. Division of victim services; duties and**
8 **responsibilities.**

9
10 (a) The division of victim services shall:

11
12 (v) Establish minimum program standards and
13 uniform reporting procedures for community based services
14 and programs for victims supported by state funds and state
15 administered federal funds, including a requirement that
16 ~~such~~ each provider of community based services and
17 ~~providers~~ programs submit an annual unduplicated count of
18 the number of victims it served in accordance with rules
19 and regulations promulgated by the division;

1 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
2 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
3 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
4 Constitution.
