1 AN ACT relating to liquor licenses; amending qualifications
2 for applicants for resort liquor licenses; and providing
3 for an effective date.

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5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 12-4-401(b)(iii) is amended to read:

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9 **12-4-401. Resort retail liquor licenses; authorized;**
10 **qualifications; provision for licenses issued prior to**
11 **January 1, 1980.**

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13 (b) To qualify for a resort retail liquor license,
14 the appropriate licensing authority shall require the
15 resort complex to:

1 (iii) Include either:

3 (A) Motel or hotel accommodations with a
4 minimum of one hundred (100) sleeping rooms; or

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6 (B) A recreation facility open to the
7 general public in which the applicant shall have invested
8 in the facility not less than ten million dollars
9 (\$10,000,000.00).
