A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the Wyoming Controlled Substances Act;
2 amending the definition of synthetic cannabinoids; and
3 providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 35-7-1014(d)(xlii)(C) and by creating
8 new subparagraphs (E) and (F) is amended to read:

10 **35-7-1014. Substances included in Schedule I.**

11

12 (d) *Hallucinogenic substances.* - Unless specifically
13 excepted or unless listed in another schedule, any
14 material, compound, mixture or preparation which contains
15 any quantity of the following hallucinogenic substances,
16 their salts, isomers and salts of isomers whenever the

1 existence of these salts, isomers and salts of isomers is
2 possible within the specific chemical designation (for
3 purposes of this paragraph only, the term "isomer" includes
4 the optical, position and geometric isomers):

6 (xlii) Synthetic cannabinoids as follows:

7

8 (C) Any compound structurally derived from
9 3-(1-naphthoyl)indole, 1H-indol-3-yl-(1-naphthyl)methane, 3-
10 (1-naphthoyl)pyrrole, ~~or~~ 3-(phenylacetyl)indole, 3-
11 (benzoyl)indole or naphthylideneindene by substitution at
12 the nitrogen atom of the indole ring, ~~or~~ pyrrole ring or 3-
13 position of the indene ring by alkyl, haloalkyl, alkenyl,
14 cycloalkylmethyl, cycloalkylethyl, 1-(N-methyl-2-
15 piperidinyl)methyl or 2-(4-morpholinyl)ethyl, whether or
16 not further substituted in the indole ring, pyrrole ring or
17 indene ring to any extent, and whether or not substituted
18 in the naphthyl or phenyl ring to any extent; ~~some trade or~~
19 ~~other names: JWH class compounds;~~

21 (E) Any compound containing a 2-(3-
22 hydroxycyclohexyl)phenol structure with substitution at the
23 5-position of the phenolic ring by an alkyl, haloalkyl,
24 alkenyl, cycloalkylmethyl, cycloalkylethyl, 1-(N-methyl-2-

1 piperidinyl)methyl or 2-(4-morpholinyl)ethyl group whether
2 or not substituted in the cyclohexyl ring to any extent;

4 (F) 2,3-Dihydro-5-methyl-3-(4-
5 morpholinylmethyl)pyrrolo[1,2,3-de]-1,4-benzoxazin-6-yl]-1-
6 naphthalenylmethanone; some trade or other names: WIN
7 55,212-2.

9 **Section 2.** W.S. 35-7-1014(d)(xlii)(D) is repealed.

11 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2012.
