A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to alcohol; providing for dispensing of  
2 samples of manufactured distilled spirits; providing for  
3 satellite facility permits for licensed manufacturers of  
4 distilled spirits; providing a definition; and providing  
5 for an effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 12-2-203 by creating new subsections  
10 (f) through (h) is amended to read:

11

12 **12-2-203. Manufacturing and rectifying; importing and**  
13 **industry representatives; licensing; fees.**

15 (f) A holder of a manufacturer's license under  
16 subsection (a) of this section who is a distiller may

1 dispense free of charge on-site samples in quantities not  
2 to exceed one and one-half (1.5) ounces of their  
3 manufactured product and no more than two (2) samples per  
4 consumer per day. The dispensing of samples shall be  
5 subject to the schedule of operating hours provided in W.S.  
6 12-5-101 and the dispensing room provisions provided in  
7 W.S. 12-5-201.

8  
9 (g) The local licensing authority may issue to the  
10 holder of a manufacturer's license under subsection (a) of  
11 this section who is a distiller, a satellite manufacturer's  
12 permit which allows the permittee to sell its manufactured  
13 product at not more than one (1) satellite location within  
14 Wyoming separate from its manufacturing site under the  
15 original permit. All products sold at a manufacturer's  
16 satellite location shall be obtained through the  
17 commission. The satellite manufacturer's permit may be  
18 issued on application to the appropriate licensing  
19 authority. The local licensing authority may require a  
20 public hearing and the payment of an additional permit fee  
21 not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100.00). The satellite  
22 manufacturer's permit shall be subject to the terms and  
23 conditions of W.S. 12-4-106, the schedule of operating

1 hours provided in W.S. 12-5-101 and the dispensing room  
2 provisions pursuant to W.S. 12-5-201.

3  
4 (h) For purposes of subsections (f) and (g) of this  
5 section, "distiller" includes any person who:

6  
7 (i) Produces distilled spirits from any source  
8 or substance;

9  
10 (ii) Brews or makes mash, wort or wash fit for  
11 distillation or for the production of distilled spirits,  
12 other than the making or using of mash, wort or wash in the  
13 authorized production of wine or beer, or the production of  
14 vinegar by fermentation;

15  
16 (iii) By any process separates alcoholic spirits  
17 from any fermented substance; or

18  
19 (iv) Making or keeping mash, wort or wash, has a  
20 still in his possession or use.

1       **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2012.
