Electrical installation licensing exceptions.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to licensing for electrical installations;
2 exempting employees of cooperative electrical utilities
3 from licensure in specified situations; and providing for
4 an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 35-9-123(a) by creating a new
9 paragraph (ix) is amended to read:

10

11 **35-9-123. Electrical installations to be performed by**
12 **licensed electricians; exceptions.**

13

14 (a) Licensed electrical contractors employing
15 licensed master or journeymen electricians, or registered
16 apprentice electricians supervised by a licensed master or
17 journeyman electrician shall install all electrical

1 equipment. This requirement is waived for the following,
2 however the waiver does not exempt the following persons
3 from meeting all other code requirements under this act:

4
5 (ix) Employees of rural electric cooperatives,
6 as defined in W.S. 37-17-101(a)(i), when performing the
7 following work:

8
9 (A) Installation of new or upgraded service
10 connections or attachments of secondary service wires to
11 any utility point of attachment on all overhead connections
12 of the cooperative's equipment to the cooperative's
13 customer's connections that are in close proximity to
14 conductors in excess of six hundred (600) volts; or

15
16 (B) Making repairs on secondary service
17 wires or reattachments of secondary service wires to any
18 utility point of attachment in emergency or outage
19 situations.

1 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
2 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
3 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
4 Constitution.
