Campaign finance reporting.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to elections; providing for filing of
2 candidates' campaign reports by the candidates' designated
3 principal campaign committees; and providing for an
4 effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 22-25-106(a)(i) through (iii), (b)(i)
9 and (c) is amended to read:

11 **22-25-106. Filing of campaign reports.**

13 (a) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (g) of
14 this section and in addition to other statements required
15 by this subsection:

16

1 (i) Every candidate shall file, or
2 alternatively, a candidate's designated principal campaign
3 committee under W.S. 22-1-102(a)(vii) shall file on behalf
4 of the candidate and the committee, a fully itemized
5 statement of receipts at least seven (7) days before any
6 primary, general or special election with information
7 required by this subsection current to any day from the
8 eighth day up to the fourteenth day before the election;

9
10 (ii) Every candidate, whether successful or not,
11 shall file, or alternatively, a candidate's designated
12 principal campaign committee under W.S. 22-1-102(a)(vii)
13 shall file on behalf of the candidate and the committee, a
14 fully itemized statement of receipts and expenditures
15 within ten (10) days after any general or special election;

16
17 (iii) Every candidate in any primary election
18 shall file, or alternatively, a candidate's designated
19 principal campaign committee under W.S. 22-1-102(a)(vii)
20 shall file on behalf of the candidate and the committee, a
21 fully itemized statement of receipts and expenditures
22 within ten (10) days after the primary election;

1 (b) Reports of itemized statements of receipt and
2 statements of receipts and expenditures, and statements of
3 termination shall be made with the appropriate filing
4 officers specified under W.S. 22-25-107 and in accordance
5 with the following:

7 (i) Except as otherwise provided in this
8 section, any political action committee, candidate's
9 campaign committee not designated as a candidate's
10 principal campaign committee under W.S. 22-1-102(a)(vii),
11 or any political action committee formed under federal law
12 or the law of another state that contributes to a Wyoming
13 political action committee or to a candidate's campaign
14 committee, any organization making an independent
15 expenditure under W.S. 22-25-102(k), and any other
16 organization supporting or opposing any ballot proposition
17 which expends any funds in any primary, general or special
18 election shall file an itemized statement of receipts at
19 least seven (7) days before the election current to any day
20 from the eighth day up to the fourteenth day before the
21 election and shall also file a statement of receipts and
22 expenditures within ten (10) days after a primary, general
23 or special election;

1 (c) All statements required by subsection (b) of this
2 section and those required by subsection (a) of this
3 section which are filed by a candidate's principal campaign
4 committee under W.S. 22-1-102(a)(vii), shall be signed by
5 both the chairman and treasurer. The statements shall set
6 forth the full and complete record of receipts including
7 cash, goods or services and except for statements of
8 receipts required under paragraph (i) of this subsection,
9 of actual and promised expenditures. The date of each
10 receipt of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) or more, any
11 expenditure or obligation, the name of the person from whom
12 received or to whom paid and the purpose of each
13 expenditure or obligation shall be listed. Nothing in this
14 subsection shall be construed to require the disclosure of
15 the names of individuals paid to circulate an initiative or
16 referendum petition. All receipts under twenty-five dollars
17 (\$25.00) shall be reported but need not be itemized. Should
18 the accumulation of receipts from an individual exceed the
19 twenty-five dollar (\$25.00) threshold, all receipts from
20 that individual shall be itemized. If the receipts,
21 expenditures or obligations were for more than one (1)
22 candidate, the amounts attributable to each shall be
23 itemized separately.
