Firefighters' license plates.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; authorizing retired
2 firefighters to receive special firefighter's license
3 plates; and providing for an effective date.

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5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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7 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-2-218(a) is amended to read:

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9 **31-2-218. Firefighter's license plates.**

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11 (a) A firefighter employed by a city, county, state
12 or duly created fire protection district, ~~or~~ a volunteer
13 firefighter as defined by W.S. 35-9-601 or a firefighter
14 retired from his department with at least ten (10) years of
15 service may apply for distinctive license plates for any
16 motor vehicle that is not a commercial vehicle or

1 multipurpose vehicle owned or leased by him upon
2 registration of the vehicle. If the firefighter became a
3 member of a bona fide fire department after January 1,
4 1995, he shall have a minimum of one (1) year service with
5 the fire department and be firefighter one certified or
6 engine boss wildfire certified in order to apply for the
7 license plate. The fire chief or his designated assistant
8 shall sign a written statement that the applicant is
9 eligible to obtain the license plate. License plates
10 issued under this section shall be displayed upon the
11 vehicle for which they are issued. The license plates
12 shall bear a distinctive symbol and letters identifying the
13 registrant as a firefighter.

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15 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2013.
