A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the supreme court; eliminating mandatory
2 distribution of opinions and session laws as specified;
3 repealing archaic provision; and providing for an effective
4 date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 5-2-402 and 5-2-502 are amended to
9 read:

11 **5-2-402. Distribution of copies of reports.**

12

13 The books delivered to the librarian shall be ~~used by him~~
14 ~~for the purpose of distribution as follows:~~ distributed as
15 provided in this section. One (1) copy of each volume shall
16 upon request be delivered to each justice of the supreme
17 court, and to each district judge there shall upon request

1 be delivered as many copies as he has counties in his
2 district, ~~and to each state officer, said books to be~~
3 ~~labeled as the property of the state, and to~~ The books
4 shall be retained in the offices of said officials and by
5 them delivered to their respective successors in office. ~~+~~
6 One (1) copy ~~shall~~ may be furnished to the library of the
7 supreme court of the United States at Washington, one (1)
8 copy to the office of the attorney general of the United
9 States, and one (1) copy to ~~the office of~~ the United States
10 district ~~judge~~ court for the district of Wyoming. The
11 remaining copies ~~shall~~ may be used in exchange for the
12 reports of other states and territories and governments as
13 ~~shall~~ may be determined upon by the justices of the supreme
14 court, and a reasonable number ~~shall~~ may be kept in the
15 state law library.

17 **5-2-502. Session law exchange.**

18

19 Upon request, the state law librarian ~~shall~~ may send to the
20 library of each state and territory of the United States,
21 free of expense, one (1) copy of the session laws of this
22 state in exchange for the laws of the requesting state or
23 territory. All the laws received in the exchange shall be

1 deposited by the state law librarian in the state law
2 library and become the property of this state.

3

4 **Section 2.** W.S. 5-2-403 is repealed.

6 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2013.
