Restricted driver's license modifications.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; modifying the conditions
2 under which a restricted driver's license may be used; and
3 providing for an effective date.

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5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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7 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-7-117(c)(intro) is amended to
8 read:

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10 **31-7-117. Restricted licenses.**

12 (c) The division may issue a restricted class "C" or
13 "M" license, or both such licenses, to a person who is
14 between the ages of fourteen (14) and sixteen (16) years
15 upon receipt of application, payment of the proper fees, an
16 affidavit of extreme inconvenience signed by the parent or

1 guardian having custody of the applicant and a finding by
2 the highway patrol that extreme inconvenience actually
3 exists. The applicant shall successfully pass the
4 examination required by W.S. 31-7-114. The licensee may
5 drive a vehicle only between the hours of 5:00 a.m. and
6 ~~8:00~~ 11:00 p.m., within a fifty (50) mile radius of his
7 domicile and only at the direction of his parent or
8 guardian. The licensee shall not transport any passenger if
9 operating a motorcycle. If any person while licensed under
10 this subsection, receives a citation for a moving
11 violation, the division, upon receipt of the notice of
12 conviction, shall suspend the license and any other license
13 or permit evidencing that person's privilege to operate a
14 motor vehicle. For purposes of this subsection "extreme
15 inconvenience" includes the following circumstances:
