Active duty medical cost reimbursement program amendments.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the military department; amending the
2 circumstances under which the adjutant general may pay
3 medical expenses incurred as a result of state active duty;
4 and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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8 **Section 1.** W.S. 19-9-403(a) is amended to read:

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10 **19-9-403. Pay and allowances of officers and enlisted**
11 **men in active state service and state active duty; worker's**
12 **compensation coverage for national guard members; no**
13 **pension denied by reason of service.**

15 (a) Officers and enlisted men while in active state
16 service shall receive the same pay and allowances as are

1 paid for the same rank and grade for service in the armed
2 forces of the United States. ~~While serving in state active~~
3 ~~duty, officers and enlisted men are entitled to receive~~
4 ~~reimbursement for~~ The adjutant general may pay or reimburse
5 reasonable medical expenses ~~paid by the~~ incurred by an
6 officer or enlisted man as a direct consequence of state
7 active duty. Medical expenses paid or reasonably eligible
8 for payment by any third party on behalf of the officer or
9 enlisted man, shall not be eligible for payment or
10 reimbursement. The adjutant general shall determine,
11 pursuant to rules and regulations adopted under this
12 subsection, whether medical expenses incurred by an officer
13 or enlisted man are the consequence of state active duty.

15 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
16 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
17 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
18 Constitution.
