A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to trade practices; providing for extension
2 of time based on force majeure provisions in new motor
3 vehicle warranty requirements; and providing for an
4 effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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8 **Section 1.** W.S. 40-17-101 by creating a new
9 subsection (j) and by renumbering (j) as (k) is amended to
10 read:

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12 **40-17-101. Definitions; express warranties; duty to**
13 **make warranty repairs.**

15 (j) The one (1) year period of time provided in
16 subsections (b) and (d) of this section shall be extended

1 by any period of time during which the vehicle could not
2 reasonably be repaired due to war, invasion, act of terror,
3 civil unrest, strike, fire, flood or natural disaster.

5 ~~(j)~~(k) Any consumer injured by a violation of this
6 section may bring a civil action to enforce this section
7 and may recover reasonable attorney's fees from the
8 manufacturer who issued the express warranty.

9

10 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2013.
