A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to water and sewer districts; providing
2 that electors and voters include qualified electors and
3 landowners; amending requirements for directors; and
4 providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 41-10-101 by creating a new
9 subsection (b), 41-10-107(d) and 41-10-112(b) are amended
10 to read:

12 **41-10-101. Definitions.**

14 (b) For purposes of this act and application of the
15 Special District Elections Act of 1994 to this act, the
16 term "electors" or "voters" include qualified electors as

1 defined in W.S. 22-29-104(a)(iv) and landowners as defined
2 in W.S. 22-29-104(a)(ii).

4 **41-10-107. Election in connection with establishment.**

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6 (d) At the formation election the voters shall vote
7 for or against the formation of the district, and for five
8 (5) ~~taxpaying~~ electors of the district, who shall
9 constitute the board of directors of the district, if
10 organized, to serve until the next regular subsequent
11 director election.

12
13 **41-10-112. Subsequent elections of members of board**
14 **of directors of district.**

15
16 (b) District board members shall serve for a term of
17 four (4) years, except that at the first regular subsequent
18 director election following the formation of the district
19 there shall be elected by the voters of the district two
20 (2) members of the board to serve for a term of two (2)
21 years and three (3) members to serve for terms of four (4)
22 years. Thereafter elections shall be held every two (2)
23 years. Each director shall be a ~~taxpaying~~ voter of the
24 district.
