

SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. SJ0001

Qualifications for University of Wyoming trustee.

A BILL

for

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION proposing to amend the Wyoming
2 Constitution to remove the requirement that a person be a
3 qualified elector of the state of Wyoming to serve as a
4 trustee of the University of Wyoming.

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6 *BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING,*
7 *two-thirds of all the members of the two houses, voting*
8 *separately, concurring therein:*

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10 **Section 1.** The following proposal to amend Wyoming
11 Constitution, Article 7, Section 17 is proposed for
12 submission to the electors of the State of Wyoming at the
13 next general election for approval or rejection to become
14 valid as a part of the Constitution if ratified by a
15 majority of the electors at the election:

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1 Article 7, Section 17. Government of university.

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3 The legislature shall provide by law for the management of
4 the university, its lands and other property by a board of
5 trustees, consisting of not less than seven members, to be
6 appointed by the governor by and with the advice and
7 consent of the senate, and the president of the university,
8 and the superintendent of public instruction, as members ex
9 officio, as such having the right to speak, but not to
10 vote. The duties and powers of the trustees shall be
11 prescribed by law. Notwithstanding Article 6, Section 15
12 of this constitution, membership on the board of trustees
13 shall not be limited to residents of the state of Wyoming.

15 **Section 2.** That the Secretary of State shall endorse
16 the following statement on the proposed amendment:

18 The adoption of this amendment would remove the requirement
19 that a person be a resident of the state of Wyoming to
20 serve as a trustee of the University of Wyoming.
