A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to crimes and offenses; modifying penalties  
2 and other provisions relating to the offense of burglary;  
3 and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 6-3-301(b) and (d) is amended to  
8 read:

9

10 **6-3-301. Burglary; aggravated burglary; penalties.**

12 (b) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this  
13 section, burglary is:

14

15 (i) A misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for  
16 not more than one (1) year, a fine of not more than one

1 thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), or both if all of the  
2 following conditions are met:

4 (A) No theft, or a theft of property with a  
5 value of less than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), was  
6 committed in the course of committing the burglary;

7

8 (B) No felony was committed in the course  
9 of committing the crime of burglary; and

10

11 (C) The building, structure, vehicle or  
12 separately secured portion thereof:

13

14 (I) Was not in fact occupied by any  
15 person other than the actor or any person voluntarily  
16 accompanying the actor at any time in the course of  
17 committing the crime of burglary;

18

19 (II) Was not locked at the time of the  
20 actor's entry; and

21

22 (III) Was not designed or adapted for  
23 overnight accommodation.
