

## HOUSE BILL NO. HB0036

Constituent service allowance.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the legislature; modifying procedures  
2 for payment of the constituent service allowance;  
3 reappropriating funds; and providing for an effective date.  
4

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*  
6

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 28-5-106(b)(iv) is amended to read:  
8

9 **28-5-106. Constituent service allowance.**  
10

11 (b) Each member of the legislature is entitled to  
12 receive a constituent service allowance as provided under  
13 this section. This allowance is intended to defray expenses  
14 incurred by each member in providing service to and on  
15 behalf of their constituents, which services are in  
16 addition to attending sessions of the legislature,  
17 attending meetings of interim committees and engaging in

1 authorized interim work for which salary, per diem and  
2 mileage is authorized by law. The allowance is subject to  
3 the following:

4  
5 (iv) The allowance of seven hundred fifty  
6 dollars (\$750.00) per calendar quarter or fractional  
7 portion thereof that the member is in office shall be paid  
8 quarterly ~~from the constituent service allowance account~~ to  
9 all incumbent legislators.

10  
11 **Section 2.** W.S. 28-5-106(a) is repealed.

12  
13 **Section 3.** Any balance remaining in the constituent  
14 service allowance account on June 30, 2014, and any amount  
15 appropriated to the constituent service allowance account  
16 by legislation enacted in the 2014 budget session is  
17 reappropriated to the legislative service office to fund  
18 constituent service allowance payments for the period  
19 beginning July 1, 2014 and ending June 30, 2016.

21 **Section 4.** This act is effective July 1, 2014.
