A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to public health; directing the department
2 of health to establish a diabetes prevention and treatment
3 plan as specified; requiring reports; and providing for an
4 effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 35-25-301 is created to read:

10 ARTICLE 3

11 DIABETES CARE PLANNING

13 **35-25-301. Diabetes care planning; reports to the**
14 **legislature.**

1 (a) The department of health shall develop a plan to
2 reduce the incidence of diabetes in Wyoming, improve
3 diabetes care, and control complications associated with
4 diabetes. The plan shall include identification of goals
5 and benchmarks.

6
7 (b) The department of health shall submit a report to
8 the joint labor, health and social services interim
9 committee by October 1 of each odd-numbered year on the
10 following:

11
12 (i) The prevalence of all types of diabetes in
13 the state and the financial impact that diabetes is having
14 on the state. Items included in this assessment shall
15 include the number of individuals with diabetes, the number
16 of individuals with diabetes and family members impacted by
17 prevention and diabetes control programs implemented by the
18 department, the financial toll or impact diabetes and its
19 complications place on the Medicaid program and the
20 financial toll or impact diabetes and its complications
21 place on the Medicaid program in comparison to other
22 chronic diseases and conditions;

1 (ii) An assessment of the benefits of
2 implemented programs and activities aimed at controlling
3 diabetes and preventing the disease;

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5 (iii) A description of the level of coordination
6 existing between the department and other agencies on
7 activities, programmatic activities and messaging on
8 managing, treating or preventing all forms of diabetes and
9 its complications;

10
11 (iv) Detailed action plans for battling diabetes
12 with a range of actionable items for consideration by the
13 legislature. The plans shall identify proposed action
14 steps to reduce the impact of diabetes, prediabetes and
15 related diabetes complications. The plan shall also
16 identify expected outcomes of the action steps proposed in
17 the following biennium while also establishing benchmarks
18 for controlling and preventing relevant forms of diabetes;
19 and

21 (v) The impact of gestational diabetes on the
22 Medicaid population, including an analysis of cost
23 implications, the number of pregnant women screened and
24 diagnosed and patient outcome measures and recommended

1 strategies to reduce the impact of the condition and to
2 improve outcomes for this population;

3

4 (vi) The development of a detailed budget
5 blueprint identifying needs, costs and resources required
6 to implement the plan developed pursuant to this section.
7 The blueprint shall include a budget range for all options
8 presented in the plan for consideration by the legislature.

9

10 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2014.
