Education-consent to release student information.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to student information; modifying the
2 consent for withdrawing from school under the age of
3 eighteen (18) to include authorization to release certain
4 student information to the national guard youth challenge
5 program; and providing for an effective date.

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7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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9 **Section 1.** W.S. 19-9-701(b) and 21-4-102(c) are
10 amended to read:

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12 **19-9-701. National guard youth challenge program;**
13 **administration of program.**

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1 (b) The national guard youth challenge program shall
2 be administered by the Wyoming military department with the
3 assistance of the department of education as necessary for
4 the provision of educational programs addressing needs of
5 the participating youth and for establishing necessary
6 communications and cooperation with Wyoming school
7 districts. Any student information obtained in accordance
8 with W.S. 21-4-102(c) by the national guard youth challenge
9 program shall be utilized for the sole purpose of
10 recruitment for the national guard youth challenge program.

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12 **21-4-102. When attendance required; exemptions;**
13 **withdrawal.**

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15 (c) In addition to subsection (a) of this section,
16 the parent, guardian or other person having control or
17 charge of any child under the age of eighteen (18), who has
18 not otherwise notified the district of enrolling that child
19 in a different school district or in a private school or
20 home-based educational program, shall meet in person with a
21 school district counselor or administrator to provide the
22 school district with written consent to the withdrawal of
23 that child from school attendance. The written consent to
24 withdrawal shall include a separate provision authorizing

1 the release of the student's identity and address to the
2 Wyoming national guard youth challenge program, as
3 established by W.S. 19-9-701, for the sole purpose of
4 recruitment into the Wyoming national guard youth challenge
5 program.

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7 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
8 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
9 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
10 Constitution.
