State miner's hospital legislative oversight committee.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to state miner's hospital; recreating the
2 state miner's hospital legislative oversight committee;
3 repealing statutes authorizing a previously terminated
4 oversight committee; providing an appropriation; and
5 providing for an effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 30-6-103 is repealed and recreated to
10 read:

12 **30-6-103. Legislative oversight committee.**

14 (a) There is created the state miner's hospital board
15 legislative oversight committee consisting of:

16

1 (i) Two (2) members of the senate appointed by
2 the president of the senate, one (1) member from each
3 political party;

4
5 (ii) Three (3) members of the house of
6 representatives appointed by the speaker, not more than two
7 (2) of whom shall be from the same political party.

8
9 (b) The committee shall include one (1) member from
10 Campbell county and one (1) member from Sweetwater county.

11
12 (c) The committee shall serve in an advisory capacity
13 to the board for the purposes of this article, and provide
14 appropriate legislative recommendations. The committee
15 shall counsel with and advise the board for the
16 administration and performance of all the duties of the
17 board pursuant to this article.

18
19 **Section 2.** There is appropriated eighteen thousand
20 dollars (\$18,000.00) from the general fund to the
21 legislative service office. This appropriation shall only
22 be expended to provide salary, travel and per diem to
23 members of the state miner's hospital board legislative
24 oversight committee for meetings held from the effective

1 date of this act through June 30, 2016. Notwithstanding any
2 other provision of law, this appropriation shall not be
3 transferred or expended for any other purpose and any
4 unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from this
5 appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30,
6 2016.

7

8 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2014.
