A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to juvenile justice; providing that
2 conditions of release from Wyoming boys' school and Wyoming
3 girls' school are imposed by the juvenile court; and
4 providing for an effective date.

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6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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8 **Section 1.** W.S. 14-6-251(a)(i)(A)(intro) and
9 14-6-252(a)(i)(A)(intro) are amended to read:

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11 **14-6-251. Sanction level four.**

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13 (a) For a child at sanction level four, the juvenile
14 court may:

2 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
