Brucellosis surveillance.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to livestock; providing for brucellosis
2 surveillance in an area of imminent concern as designated
3 by the livestock board; modifying the compensation
4 provision accordingly; and providing for an effective date.

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6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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8 **Section 1.** W.S. 11-19-407(a) is amended to read:

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10 **11-19-407. Brucellosis testing program.**

12 (a) The livestock board shall develop a brucellosis
13 surveillance program in ~~the~~any designated surveillance
14 area as defined by the livestock board and any area of
15 concern designated by the board and approved by the
16 governor as an area where risk of exposure to documented

1 infected wildlife is of imminent concern. The program may
2 be conducted with the help of veterinary practitioners and
3 livestock auction markets. This program shall provide for
4 the testing of livestock for brucellosis, for spaying
5 heifers and for adult vaccinations only to the extent that
6 may be reasonably necessary to maintain or to regain the
7 brucellosis-free status of the state of Wyoming.
8 Compensation under this program for all purposes except
9 mandatory testing or testing within an area of imminent
10 concern as designated by the board and approved by the
11 governor shall be pursuant to the terms of a livestock herd
12 plan that has been entered into between the livestock
13 producer and the Wyoming state veterinarian.

15 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
16 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
17 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
18 Constitution.
