State parks-ATM donations.

Sponsored by: Joint Travel, Recreation, Wildlife and
Cultural Resources Interim Committee

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to state parks; providing for agreements
2 between the department of state parks and cultural
3 resources and operators of remote electronic terminals for
4 the collection of donations; providing restrictions; and
5 providing for an effective date.

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7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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9 **Section 1.** W.S. 13-1-502 by creating a new subsection
10 (p) and 36-4-104(a) by creating a new paragraph (vi) are
11 amended to read:

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13 **13-1-502. Remote electronic terminals.**

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15 (p) A Wyoming financial institution, financial
16 institution or person operating a remote electronic

1 terminal in this state may enter into an agreement with the
2 department of state parks and cultural resources to provide
3 users a voluntary opportunity to donate funds for the
4 operation and maintenance of state parks, historic sites
5 and recreation areas. The opportunity for donation shall
6 be disclosed visually by electronic display in a manner
7 that suggests an amount of donation, allows a user to
8 designate the amount of the donation desired, or make no
9 donation if so desired by the user. No additional charges
10 for making the donation shall be charged to the user by the
11 Wyoming financial institution, financial institution or
12 person operating the remote electronic terminal. The
13 department of state parks and cultural resources and the
14 Wyoming financial institution, financial institution or
15 person operating the remote electronic terminal may include
16 in the agreement provisions for retention of a portion of
17 the donated funds as an administrative fee in an amount not
18 to exceed ten percent (10%) of the donations collected or
19 five dollars (\$5.00) per transaction, whichever is less.

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21 **36-4-104. Powers; interpretive service agreements.**

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(a) The department of state parks and cultural resources, in consultation with the commission, may, subject to the provisions of this act:

(vi) Enter into agreements with Wyoming financial institutions, financial institutions or persons operating remote electronic terminals for the collection of donations for the operation and maintenance of Wyoming state parks, historic sites and recreation areas. Donations received by the department pursuant to this paragraph shall be deposited in an operations and maintenance account and upon legislative appropriation shall be expended by the department for the daily operation of outdoor locations and facilities as described in W.S. 36-4-103.

Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
