A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the Wyoming cultural trust fund board;
2 expanding membership on the board; providing for ex officio
3 membership on the board; removing voting right of ex
4 officio member; specifying qualifications for board
5 members; providing an appropriation; and providing for an
6 effective date.

8 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9

10 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-2-2305(a) is amended to read:

11

12 **9-2-2305. Wyoming cultural trust fund board;**
13 **creation; members.**

1 (a) There is created the Wyoming cultural trust fund
2 board. The board shall consist of ~~five (5)~~ six (6) members,
3 as follows:

4
5 (i) The administrator of the division of
6 cultural resources or his designee who shall serve as an ex
7 officio member of the board, without a vote; and

8
9 (ii) ~~Four (4)~~ Five (5) persons appointed by the
10 governor and confirmed by the senate who are residents of
11 Wyoming. Board membership shall reflect a broad spectrum
12 of experiences, including, but not limited to, the arts,
13 history, archaeology, humanities and cultural and heritage
14 tourism and shall be selected from the following nominees:

15
16 (A) ~~Two (2) persons~~ One (1) person
17 nominated by the Wyoming commission on parks and cultural
18 resources; ~~and~~

20 (B) Two (2) persons nominated by the
21 Wyoming arts council board; ~~and~~ and

23 (C) Two (2) persons nominated by the
24 Wyoming national register review board.

2 **Section 2.** There is appropriated three thousand
3 dollars (\$3,000.00) from the general fund to the Wyoming
4 cultural trust fund board. This appropriation shall be for
5 the period beginning with the effective date of this act
6 and ending June 30, 2016. This appropriation shall only be
7 expended for the purpose of staffing the cultural trust
8 fund board. Notwithstanding any other provision of law,
9 this appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for
10 any other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds
11 remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided
12 by law on June 30, 2016.

13

14 **Section 3.** This act is effective March 1, 2015.
