

[TO SUBSTITUTE BILL No. 1]

Delete the Scott Second Reading Amendment (HB0114S2003/A) entirely and further amend as follows:

Page 9-line 22 Delete "." Insert ";".

Page 9-After line 22 Insert:

"(iii) Supersede, or empower a local governing body by authorization or condition upon any authorization made pursuant to this section to supersede, any provision of W.S. 6-8-104(cc) or (dd).".

Page 13-line 1 After "(intro)" insert "and by creating new subsections (cc) and (dd)".

Page 13-After line 11 insert:

"(cc) Any person twenty-one (21) years of age or older who may lawfully possess a firearm, may have that firearm in a private motor vehicle on any road, street, driveway or parking area within the grounds of any public facility in which the carrying of concealed weapons or firearms is prohibited under subsection (t) of this section, provided the firearm is not loaded and in a locked container, or a locked firearms rack that is on a motor vehicle.

(dd) The governor may prohibit the application of subsection (cc) of this section if he determines, in his sole discretion, that the under particular circumstances the presence of a firearm in a private motor vehicle poses a significant threat to safety and security. The exercise of authority under this subsection shall be by executive order." COE
