19 expungement of the person's records under subsection (d) of this
20 section;
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22 (iii) That the district attorney may petition the
23 court to postpone the expungement of records under this section
24 and that the person shall be provided notice and opportunity to
25 contest the district attorney's petition.

27 (f) As used in this section, "expungement" means the
28 proceedings in a person's case are deemed never to have occurred
29 and the person may reply accordingly upon any inquiry in the
