30 (a) This act shall apply prospectively. The academic
31 performance of Hathaway scholarship recipients prior to the
32 effective date of this act shall not be considered in
33 determining eligibility to receive an increase of the Hathaway
34 scholarship based on academic performance in accordance with
35 W.S. 21-16-1304(j) or 21-16-1305(f), as amended by section 1 of
36 this act. All Hathaway scholarship recipients as of the
37 effective date of this act shall be eligible to earn an increase
38 of the Hathaway scholarship based on academic performance in
39 accordance with W.S. 21-16-1304(j) or 21-16-1305(f), as amended
40 by section 1 of this act.
