1 (n) A foreign registered limited liability partnership
2 whose registration has lapsed for failure to pay fees or failure
3 to maintain a registered agent in this state as provided in this
4 article may apply to the secretary of state for reinstatement
5 within two (2) years after the effective date of lapse as
6 provided in W.S. 17-21-1107.

8 **Section 3.** Effective immediately, there is appropriated
9 from the general fund to the secretary of state one-time funding
10 of forty-seven thousand dollars (\$47,000.00) to implement the
11 purposes of this act. Any unexpended, unobligated funds
12 appropriated under this section shall revert on June 30, 2016 as
13 provided by law.
