- (A) One (1) member of the state board of education;
- (B) One (1) member employed by the University of Wyoming or one (1) of the seven (7) community colleges;
- (C) One (1) school district superintendent from a school district administering distance education programs;
- (D) Two (2) program directors of distance education programs;
- (E) One (1) distance education teacher;
- (F) One (1) curriculum coordinator;
- (G) One (1) school district technology director;

(J) One (1) representative from the department of enterprise technology;

(K) Two (2) parents of a student or students enrolled in a distance education program;

(L) One (1) student enrolled in a distance education program."
