A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to professional licensing; granting the
2 board of barber examiners authority to establish
3 requirements as specified; providing a definition; and
4 providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 33-7-101(a) by creating a new
9 paragraph (vi) and by renumbering (vi) as (vii) and
10 33-7-209(a)(iii) are amended to read:

12 **33-7-101. Definitions.**

14 (a) As used in this act:

15

1 (vi) "Instructor" means a person licensed to
2 teach barbering or any practices thereof in a school of
3 barbering as defined by this act and rules of the board;

5 ~~(vi)~~ (vii) "This act" means W.S. 33-7-101 through
6 33-7-211.

8 **33-7-209. Qualifications for registration as barber;**
9 **examination.**
10

11 (a) A certificate of registration to practice
12 barbering shall be issued upon passage of a board
13 administered or board approved examination, and upon
14 meeting all requirements set forth by board rule and
15 regulation, to any person who files a completed
16 application, accompanied by the required fees and
17 documentation and who:

19 (iii) Is a cosmetologist or hair stylist
20 licensed under W.S. 33-12-119 through 33-12-140, has
21 completed ~~seven hundred fifty (750) hours of~~ training at an
22 approved barber school or college as set forth in board

1 rules and regulations and passed an examination conducted
2 by the board to determine his fitness for practice.

4 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2015.
