Front license plate requirement.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to motor vehicle registration; providing
2 that front license plates need not be displayed on certain
3 vehicles as specified; and providing for an effective date.

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5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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7 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-2-205(a)(i)(A) is amended to read:

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9 **31-2-205. Display of license plates.**

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11 (a) License plates for vehicles shall be:

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13 (i) Conspicuously displayed and securely
14 fastened to be plainly visible:

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1 (A) One (1) on the front of the vehicle,
2 excluding the following:

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4 (I) Motorcycles;

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6 (II) Multipurpose vehicles;

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8 (III) Trailers, including house
9 trailers;

10 (IV) Vehicles operated with demo, full
11 use or manufacturer license plates issued pursuant to W.S.
12 31-16-125;

13 (V) Street rods registered pursuant to
14 W.S. 31-2-226; and

15
16 (VI) Custom vehicles registered
17 pursuant to W.S. 31-2-227; ~~provided that such custom~~
18 ~~vehicles were manufactured prior to 1968 or were originally~~
19 ~~manufactured to have one (1) license plate;~~

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21 (VII) Antique vehicles registered
22 pursuant to W.S. 31-2-223;

1 (VIII) A motor vehicle which was
2 originally manufactured without a bracket, device or other
3 means to display and secure a front license plate.

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5 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2015.
