A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to elections; providing that a candidate's
2 campaign committee may file reports for the candidate as
3 specified; and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 22-25-106(a) (intro) and by creating a
8 new subsection (j) is amended to read:

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10 **22-25-106. Filing of campaign reports.**

12 (a) Except as otherwise provided in ~~subsection (g)~~
13 subsections (g) and (j) of this section and in addition to
14 other statements required by this subsection:

1 (j) If a candidate has formed a candidate's campaign
2 committee, the committee may file reports required by this
3 section on behalf of the candidate if the candidate
4 provides a signed document one (1) time each election cycle
5 authorizing the committee to file reports on behalf of the
6 candidate and attesting that the facts provided in the
7 report are accurate. If a committee has filed a required
8 report on behalf of a candidate under this subsection, the
9 candidate shall not be required to separately file the
10 report provided that the candidate shall remain
11 individually responsible for any deficiencies in a report
12 filed by the committee.

14 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2015.
