A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to state historic sites; accepting transfer
2 of land for Quebec 1 missile alert facility state historic
3 site; providing for administration of the historic site as
4 a seasonal facility; providing appropriations; and
5 providing for an effective date.

ARTICLE 16

QUEBEC 1 MISSILE ALERT FACILITY

11

12 **Section 1.** W.S. 36-8-1601 and 36-8-1602 are created
13 to read:

14

1 **36-8-1601. Authorizing acceptance of land transfer;**
2 **declaration of Quebec 1 missile alert facility state**
3 **historic site.**

4
5 (a) The legislature authorizes the acceptance of the
6 Quebec 1 missile alert facility from the United States
7 department of the air force to the department of state
8 parks and cultural resources upon final negotiation with
9 the appropriate parties.

10
11 (b) Upon transfer of land, the Quebec 1 missile alert
12 facility is declared to be a state historic site and shall
13 be known as the "Quebec 1 missile alert facility state
14 historic site".

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16 **36-8-1602. Administration.**

17
18 The department of state parks and cultural resources shall
19 hold title to and administer, operate and maintain the
20 historic site in accordance with the National Historic
21 Preservation Act of 1966, as amended, and the programmatic
22 agreement between the United States department of the air
23 force and the department of state parks and cultural

1 resources. The historic site shall be open to the public
2 for a seasonal period as determined by the department of
3 state parks and cultural resources.

5 **Section 2.**

6
7 (a) There is appropriated one hundred sixty-five
8 thousand dollars (\$165,000.00) from the general fund to the
9 department of state parks and cultural resources. This
10 appropriation shall only be expended for site
11 interpretation, plans and exhibits at the Quebec 1 missile
12 alert facility state historic site and for capital
13 improvements such as landscaping, roads, parking areas and
14 other similar and necessary improvements. This
15 appropriation shall not be included in the department's
16 2017-2018 standard biennial budget request.

17
18 (b) There is appropriated ten thousand dollars
19 (\$10,000.00) from the general fund to the department of
20 state parks and cultural resources. This appropriation
21 shall only be expended for equipment necessary to maintain
22 and operate the Quebec 1 missile alert facility state
23 historic site. This appropriation shall not be included in

1 the department's 2017-2018 standard biennial budget
2 request.

3

4 (c) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, funds
5 appropriated in subsections (a) and (b) of this section,
6 shall not be transferred or expended for any other purpose
7 and any unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from these
8 appropriations shall revert as provided by law on June 30,
9 2019.

10

11 **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon
12 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
13 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
14 Constitution.
