A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to prioritization of municipal solid waste
2 facilities cease and transfer projects; authorizing
3 expenditure of previously appropriated funds; establishing
4 a prioritized list of projects; establishing a maximum
5 amount to be expended on the projects listed; authorizing
6 the department of environmental quality limited
7 discretionary authority to modify the prioritized list;
8 providing definitions; repealing a prior list of priority
9 cease and transfer projects; and providing for an effective
10 date.

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12 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

14 **Section 1.**

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1 (a) As used in this section:

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3 (i) "Maximum amount" means the total amount to
4 be expended on the listed project and reflects one hundred
5 percent (100%) of the project cost, including any award by
6 the state loan and investment board under W.S. 35-11-528.
7 As provided in W.S. 35-11-528, no grant or loan shall
8 exceed seventy-five percent (75%) of the total cost of
9 cease and transfer activities of the municipal waste
10 facility;

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12 (ii) "(C)" means closure project;

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14 (iii) "SWDD" means solid waste disposal
15 district;

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17 (iv) "(T)" means transfer projects.

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19 (b) From amounts appropriated by 2013 Wyoming Session
20 Laws, Chapter 194, Section 2(a) and (b), 2014 Wyoming
21 Session Laws, Chapter 26, Section 333(a) and (b) and other
22 funds appropriated and authorized for program expenses, the
23 following amounts and prioritized projects are authorized

1 pursuant to the municipal solid waste facilities cease and
2 transfer grant and loan account program created by W.S.
3 35-11-528:

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7 (c) The department of environmental quality may
8 modify the authorized funds and the order of the projects
9 listed in the prioritized list contained in subsection (b)
10 of this section for any of the following reasons:

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12 (i) To optimize efficiency;

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14 (ii) Based on project readiness;

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16 (iii) Based on compliance with grant or loan
17 qualifications or conditions;

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19 (iv) To address emergency or immediate
20 environmental concerns.

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22 (d) Not later than October 15 of each year, the
23 department of environmental quality shall report any

1 modification of the prioritized list contained in
2 subsection (b) of this section to the joint minerals,
3 business and economic development interim committee and the
4 joint appropriations interim committee.

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6 **Section 2.** 2014 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 52 is
7 repealed.

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9 **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon
10 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
11 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
12 Constitution.
