A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the controlled substances prescription
2 tracking program; amending the timeframe for reporting
3 prescriptions of controlled substances as specified;
4 repealing the sunsetted pilot program; and providing for an
5 effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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9 **Section 1.** W.S. 35-7-1060(b) and (c)(i) is amended to
10 read:

12 **35-7-1060. Controlled substances prescription**
13 **tracking program.**

1 (b) All prescriptions for schedule II, III and IV
2 controlled substances dispensed by any retail pharmacy
3 licensed by the board shall be filed with the board
4 electronically or by other means required by the board no
5 ~~more than seven (7) days after dispensed.~~ later than the
6 close of business on the business day immediately following
7 the day the controlled substance was dispensed. The board
8 may require the filing of other prescriptions and may
9 specify the manner in which the prescriptions are filed.

11 (c) The tracking program shall not be used to
12 infringe on the legal use of a controlled substance.
13 Information obtained through the controlled substance
14 prescription tracking program is confidential and may not
15 be released and is not admissible in any judicial or
16 administrative proceeding, except as follows:

18 (i) The board may release information to
19 practitioners and practitioner appointed delegates and to
20 pharmacists and pharmacist appointed delegates when the
21 release of the information may be of assistance in
22 preventing or avoiding inappropriate use of controlled
23 substances;

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2 **Section 2.** W.S. 35-7-1061 and 35-7-1062 are repealed.

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4 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2015.
