A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to elections; specifying when candidates
2 running unopposed are required to file campaign reports;
3 and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 22-25-106(a)(i) through (iii) is
8 amended to read:

10 **22-25-106. Filing of campaign reports.**

12 (a) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (g) of
13 this section and in addition to other statements required
14 by this subsection:

15

1 (i) Every candidate, except a candidate that is
2 running unopposed, shall file a fully itemized statement of
3 receipts at least seven (7) days before any primary,
4 general or special election with information required by
5 this subsection current to any day from the eighth day up
6 to the fourteenth day before the election;

7
8 (ii) Except as otherwise provided in this
9 paragraph, every candidate, whether successful or not,
10 shall file a fully itemized statement of receipts and
11 expenditures within ten (10) days after any general or
12 special election. A candidate that was running unopposed
13 shall file the statement required under this paragraph not
14 later than December 31 of the year in which the election
15 occurred;

16
17 (iii) Except as otherwise provided in this
18 paragraph, every candidate in any primary election shall
19 file a fully itemized statement of receipts and
20 expenditures within ten (10) days after the primary
21 election. A candidate that was running unopposed shall file
22 the statement required under this paragraph not later than
23 seven (7) days before the general election unless the

1 candidate is also running unopposed in the general election
2 in which case the candidate shall not be required to file a
3 statement under this paragraph;

5 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2015.
