Catch Title: State parks-use of fees.

Subject: State Parks and Cultural Resources.

Summary/Major Elements:

- Current law restricts use of funds received from the sale of certain permits by the Department of State Parks and Cultural Resources to capital construction projects, major maintenance and site interpretation.
- This bill authorizes the Department, with legislative approval, to use not more than 25% of those funds for maintenance of outdoor recreation areas and facilities provided that the funds are not used for additional full-time employees, increases in salaries or overtime pay for full-time employees.

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
