Catch Title: Aggregate campaign contribution limits-repeal.

Subject: Campaign finance.

Summary/Major Elements:

- Under prior law, no individual, other than a candidate or the candidate's immediate family, was allowed to make total political contributions of more than \$50,000 in any two-year period of time. This limit was known as Wyoming's aggregate campaign contribution limit.
- This legislation repeals Wyoming's aggregate campaign contribution limit in accordance with recent case law from the United States Supreme Court which indicates the aggregate limit is unconstitutional.

Comments:

- The repeal of the aggregate campaign contribution limit does not impact other, individual campaign contribution limits established by W.S. 22-25-102.

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
