Catch Title: Unclaimed property-advertising.

Subject: Authorizes unclaimed property to be advertised in a manner determined by the State Treasurer.

Summary/Major Elements:

- Under current law, the administrator (the State Treasurer) must advertise unclaimed property in a newspaper circulating in Wyoming through an advertisement that contains specific information about the unclaimed property and the apparent owner.
- This bill repeals the requirement to advertise unclaimed property in a newspaper and allows the administrator discretion to advertise the unclaimed property in a manner that is likely to attract the attention of the apparent owner.
