Catch Title: Development of education standards.

Subject: Modifies process for adoption of the educational student and content performance standards.

Summary/Major Elements:

- This bill requires the State Board of Education, in consultation with the State Superintendent, to establish a process to accept public comments between the times of formal review by the State Board.
- This bill requires the State Board of Education to evaluate and review the uniformity and quality of the student and content performance standards not less than once every nine (9) years.
- Previously, the law required the State Board to review the standards not less than once every five (5) years.

Comments:

- Amends a major program: adoption of statewide educational student and content performance standards.

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
