**Catch Title:** Wyoming retirement system-veteran's service credit.  
**Subject:** Authorizes purchase of retirement service credit by veterans

**Summary/Major Elements:**

- This bill authorizes State employees who are honorably discharged veterans to purchase service credits in the Wyoming Retirement System. Any purchase of service credits shall be:
  - Subject to rules of the Retirement Board and the Internal Revenue Code's limits on credit purchases;
  - Limited to one year of credit for each year of military service, up to a maximum of eight years;
  - Conditioned upon payment by the employee of a lump sum equal to the actuarially-determined, age-adjusted cost of the credits;
  - Used to calculate pension benefits, but not to determine vesting;
  - Applicable to retirement plans for State employees, Highway Patrol/game wardens, judges and firefighters.
