Catch Title: Health provider recruiting programs.

Subject: Modifies health care provider loan reimbursement and recruitment programs

Summary/Major Elements:

- This bill:
 - Increases from \$10,000 to \$20,000 the amount of loan reimbursements available under W.S. 9-2-119 for allied health care providers agreeing to practice in underserved areas of Wyoming;
 - Expands the physician recruitment program established by W.S. 35-1-1101 to apply to all health care providers licensed under Title 33;
 - Repeals a requirement that the Department of Health, in implementing the recruitment program, attempt to recruit at least half of providers into private practice.
