Catch Title: Resort liquor licenses.

Subject: Resort retail liquor license regulation.

Summary/Major Elements:

- Under current law, to qualify for a resort retail liquor license, a resort complex must, in addition to other requirements: 1) have motel or hotel accommodations with a minimum of 100 rooms, or 2) be a ski resort facility in which the applicant committed or expended \$10 million or more.
- This bill expands the type of accommodations an eligible resort complex may have beyond “motel or hotel accommodations” to include privately owned condominiums, town houses or home accommodations approved for short-term occupancy with a minimum of 100 rooms.
- This bill provides a resort liquor licensee may contract with a person to provide food and beverages on licensed premises without needing to transfer the resort liquor license to that person.

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
