Catch Title: Cigarette certification.

Subject: Removes the State Fire Marshal from many aspects of the Wyoming Reduced Cigarette Ignition Propensity Act.

Summary/Major Elements:

- Currently, a cigarette cannot be sold in the State of Wyoming without first being tested and certified for ignition propensities, presumably to reduce fires started by cigarettes.
- The State Fire Marshal administers the program in conjunction with the Department of Revenue.
- This Act removes the State Fire Marshal from many of the administrative duties under the program and places those duties with the Department of Revenue.

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
