Catch Title: Termination of employment-wages.

Subject: Amends deadline for payment of wages to former employee.

Summary/Major Elements:

- Current law requires payment of wages within five days of termination to an employee who quits or is discharged from employment.
- This act changes the five-day requirement to “no later than the employer's usual practice on regularly scheduled payroll dates.”

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
