Catch Title: Notice requirements special district elections.

Subject: Use of Business Days to Compute when Notice is Required in the Special District Elections Act.

Summary/Major Elements:

- Currently in statute, there are various time periods or requirements to provide notice in the Special District Elections Act (W.S. 22-29-101 through 22-29-601). The Special District Elections Act does not specify whether the time periods or notice runs at the expiration of the specified calendar days or business days.
- This Act specifies for any notice or time period 10 days or under, the time period expires at the conclusion of the specified business days.
- Provides a definition that a “business day” means any day other than Saturday, Sunday or a legal holiday.

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
