Catch Title: Speeding penalties in 80 mile per hour zone.

Subject: Speeding penalties in 80 mile per hour zone.

Summary/Major Elements:

- 2014 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 49, allowed the Director of the Department of Transportation to establish a speed limit not to exceed 80 miles per hour on designated interstate highways. Under current law, the penalty for a speeding violation on those designated interstate highways differs from the penalty for an equivalent speeding violation on interstate highways with a maximum speed limit not to exceed 75 miles per hour.
- This bill specifies the penalty for a speeding violation on designated interstate highways with a maximum speed limit not to exceed 80 miles per hour is the same as the penalty for an equivalent speeding violation on interstate highways with a maximum speed limit not to exceed 75 miles per hour.
