Catch Title: Community juvenile services boards-creation.

Subject: Authorizes counties to form community juvenile services boards as administrative boards.

Summary/Major Elements:

- Under current law, a county may enter into an agreement to form a joint powers board with cities, towns, other counties, school districts and other governmental entities to serve as community juvenile services boards. Community juvenile services boards review services available for juveniles within their catchment area, develop strategic plans, and develop and coordinate services for juveniles.
- This bill allows an agreement between the entities, otherwise authorized to form a joint powers board, to form a community juvenile services board without actually forming a joint powers board, although the board formed would still have to comply with the W.S. 16-1-105, procedures relating to joint agreements necessary for the creation of a joint powers board.
- This bill is an effort to eliminate some costs related to the formation of a joint powers board.
