Catch Title: Regulation freedom.

Subject: Calls for constitutional amendment to provide Congress with regulation override authority

Summary/Major Elements:

- This Joint Resolution to Congress:
 - o Recites the growth and abuse of federal regulatory authority threatens constitutional liberties;
 - o Recites that regulators must be more accountable to elected representatives;
 - o Urges Congress to initiate the amendment process to adopt the following amendment to the United States Constitution:

“Whenever one quarter of the members of the United States House of Representatives or the United States Senate transmits to the President their written declaration of opposition to a proposed federal regulation, it shall require a majority vote of the House of Representatives and the Senate to adopt that regulation.”

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
