Catch Title: Motor vehicle driver's license exemptions.

Subject: Modifications to drivers' license classifications.

Summary/Major Elements:

- This act:
 - Repeals drivers' license classifications known as non-commercial class A and class B and replaces them with an endorsement "Z" for a class C license;
 - Makes a "Z" endorsement (for vehicles with a gross vehicle weight exceeding 39,001 pounds) available to previous holders of class A or class B licenses, to persons who pass a written and skills test or to persons who submit an affidavit of competency signed by a person licensed to operated a vehicle of that weight;
 - Amends the wording of exemptions from commercial drivers' license requirements for emergency and military vehicles, in order to make the state exemptions consistent with federal CDL exemptions.

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
