Catch Title: Interstate Mining Compact commission membership.

Subject: Adopts the Interstate Mining Compact and Provides for Full Membership for the State of Wyoming on the Interstate Mining Compact Commission.

Summary/Major Elements:

- Currently, Wyoming is an associate member of the Interstate Mining Compact Commission. The director of the Department of Environmental Quality acts as the Governor's designee on the Commission.
- To become a full member of the Interstate Mining Compact Commission, Wyoming must adopt the Interstate Mining Compact.
- This act adopts the Interstate Mining Compact.
- Provides the State of Wyoming may join the Interstate Mining Compact Commission.
- Allows the Governor to appoint a designee to the Commission to perform all functions of in connection with business of the Compact.
- Allows for payment of membership fees to the Commission from mining permit fees collected by the Department of Environmental Quality.
